Bergen Center for Competition Law and Economics (BECCLE) is pleased to announce the seventh annual conference on competition policy on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of June 2023 in Bergen, Norway. The conference will combine sessions with invited speakers with presentations and discussions of original research papers in the fields of competition law and competition economics.

For the open sessions at the BECCLE conference, we now invite submissions of original research papers. Papers should be in the field of competition law and economics. We welcome both theoretical and empirical papers, as well as case studies. Lawyers are especially encouraged to submit papers.

#### Submission of papers

Papers should be submitted as a pdf file to <u>conference2023BECCLE@uib.no</u>, no later than March 1, 2023. Submissions should include title, abstract (up to 200 words), authors' name and affiliations, and contact details. Submissions of full papers are recommended, but we will also accept extended abstracts.

Authors of accepted papers will be notified no later than March 31, 2023. All papers will be allocated a discussant, and presenters may be asked to discuss a paper.

• Professor Natalia Fabra, Department of Economics at Universidad Carlos III Madrid: *Reform in the European electricity market* 

• Professor Heike Schweitzer, Faculty of Law at Humboldt University in Berlin: *Ex ante vs ex post enforcement of competition law* 

In addition, there will be invited sessions on the energy sector (organized by Ignacio Herrera Anchustegui at Faculty of Law at University of Bergen) and enforcement of competition law (will be announced later).
